Objectives: Shoot Video & Obtain Outsourced clip

- assemble all of the footage necessary to edit your video

1) Remind your partners that the video clip you requested is Due November 1.

This clip is to be sent via yousendit.com to the **teacher** of the student (in other words, to me). See the video specifications on the wiki for details.

2) Send video to your partners

As soon as you receive a request for a clip from your sub-group, complete it.

This clip is to be sent via yousendit.com to the **teacher** of the student.

Create the clip according to these specifications:

Size: no larger than 30 MB

Format: .mov – unedited it preferred

Audio: uncompressed

Length: 1 – 4 min.

Send via yousendit.com to the teacher of the student. **Label the subject clearly** with the name of the student requesting the clip, school name, group number, group letter, and your name. Example: To RawanZ, QA, Group 1A, from Amalia.

Using a Word document, **write a brief description** of the clip you sent. Attach it to this sheet.

Include when you sent it and how it will fit into your partner's video.

3) Shoot your video & store on your computer.

- You may use either a videocam or a series of still digital images.

Shoot for quality. Consider:

Lighting. Can you clearly see the subjects? Tip: do not shoot into light.

Stability (Use a tripod if possible.).

Sound. (Avoid as much background interference as possible.)

Timing (Start filming before the action starts and continue a bit after to allow for editing options.
