2) Write your introduction-

Write your introduction audio file answering the following questions -- YOU MAY NOT USE YOUR WHOLE NAME -- First name only (and last initial if another student has your same name at your school.) -- Please ask me to read it before recording.

- * Explain who you are, where you live and what school you go to
- * Tell a little about what life is like where you live
- * Tell a little about what you do at school, for a hobby etc
- * Share your ideas for the project:
 - o How do you think you will cope collaborating with students in other countries?
 - O What will be the advantages?
 - O What will be the disadvantages?
 - O What new skills will you need to learn to be able to do this project?

3) Record your introduction

- 1) Get a headset from the headset area
- 2) Open Audacity (the program on your computer)
- 3) Click Record -- Record your file and edit as you choose.
- 4) You will need to export as an mp3 file (You may need to see the information on the Wiki)
**Name it with your first name, last initial and school -- WHS for Westwood)

4) Upload your introduction to the Ning

Click on My Page -- upload an audio file (mp3) -- test it to make sure it came through correctly.
